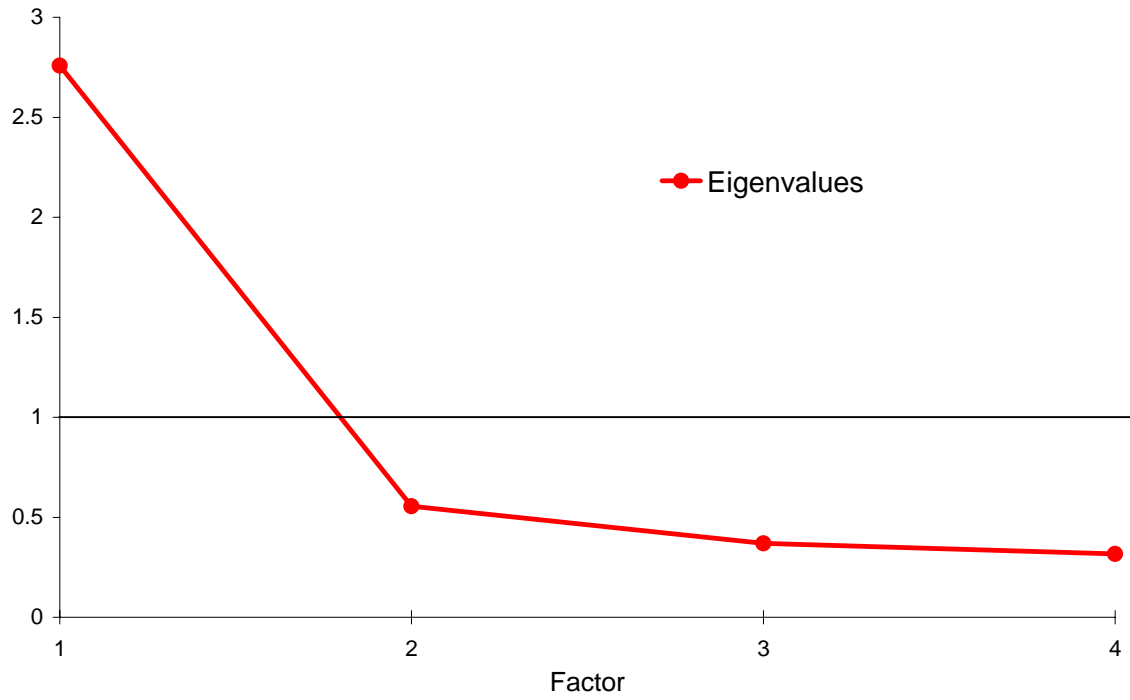
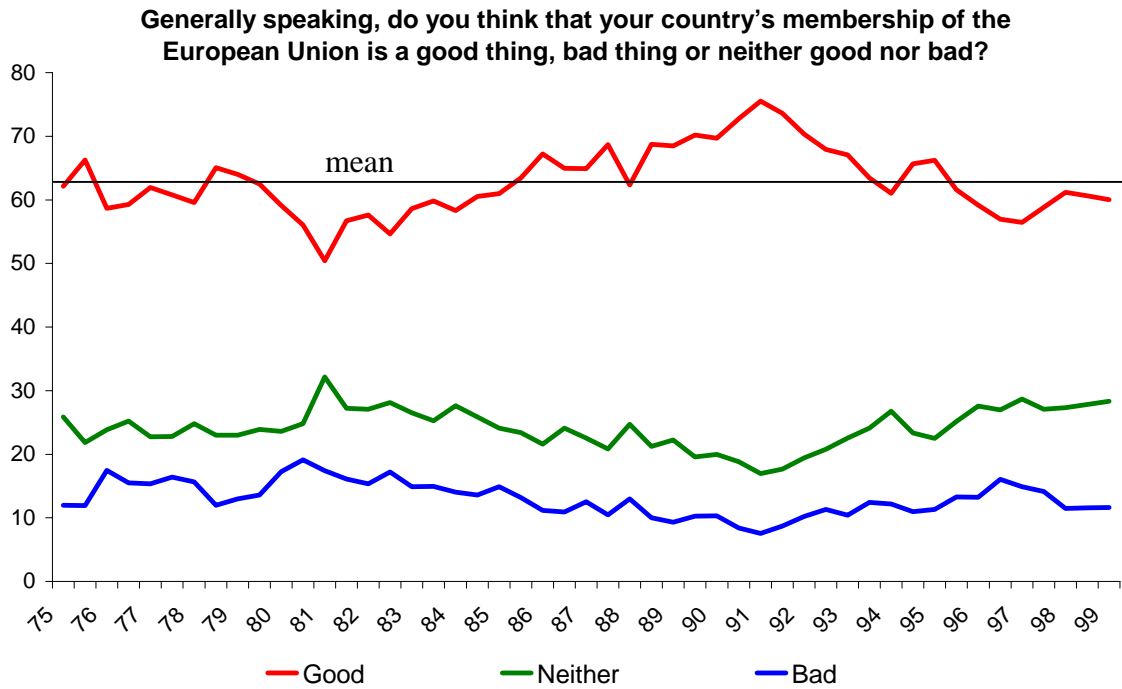

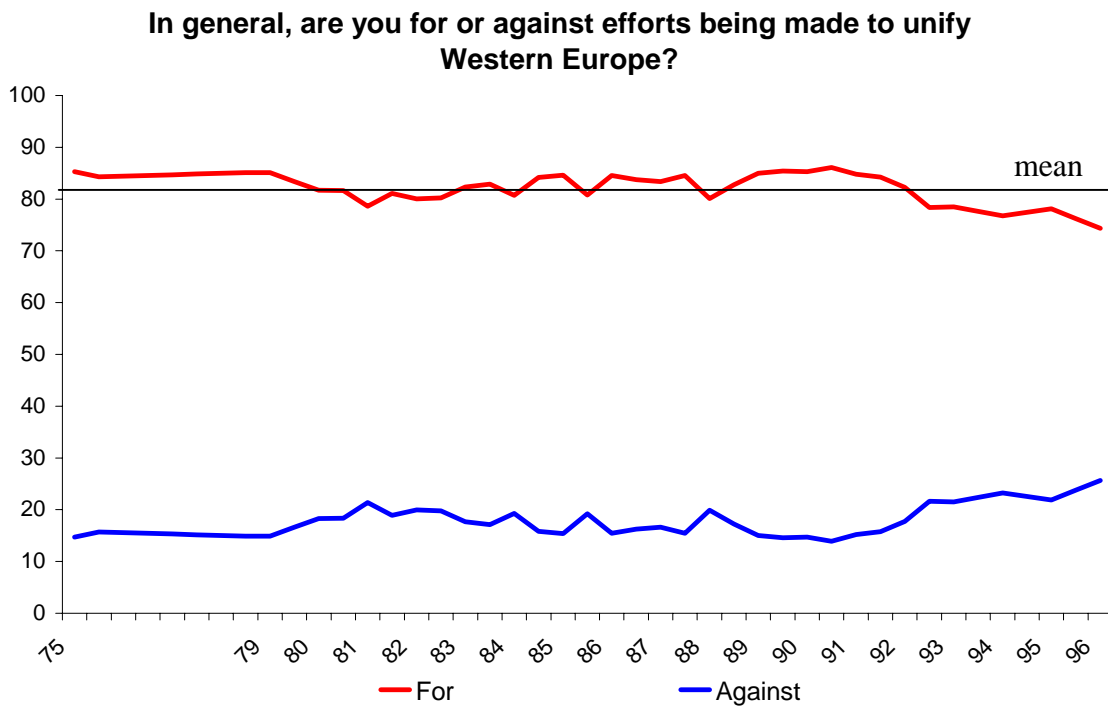
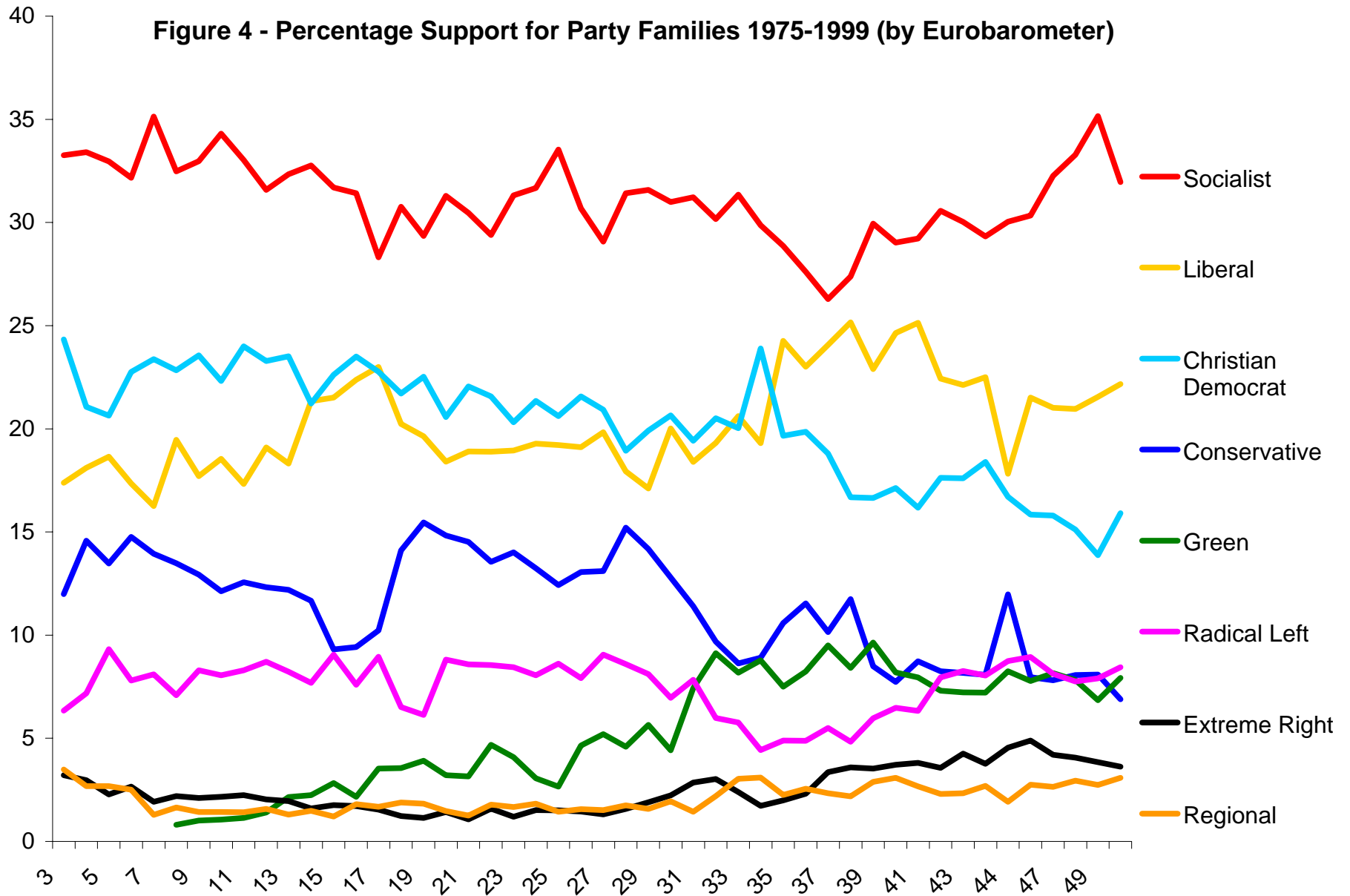
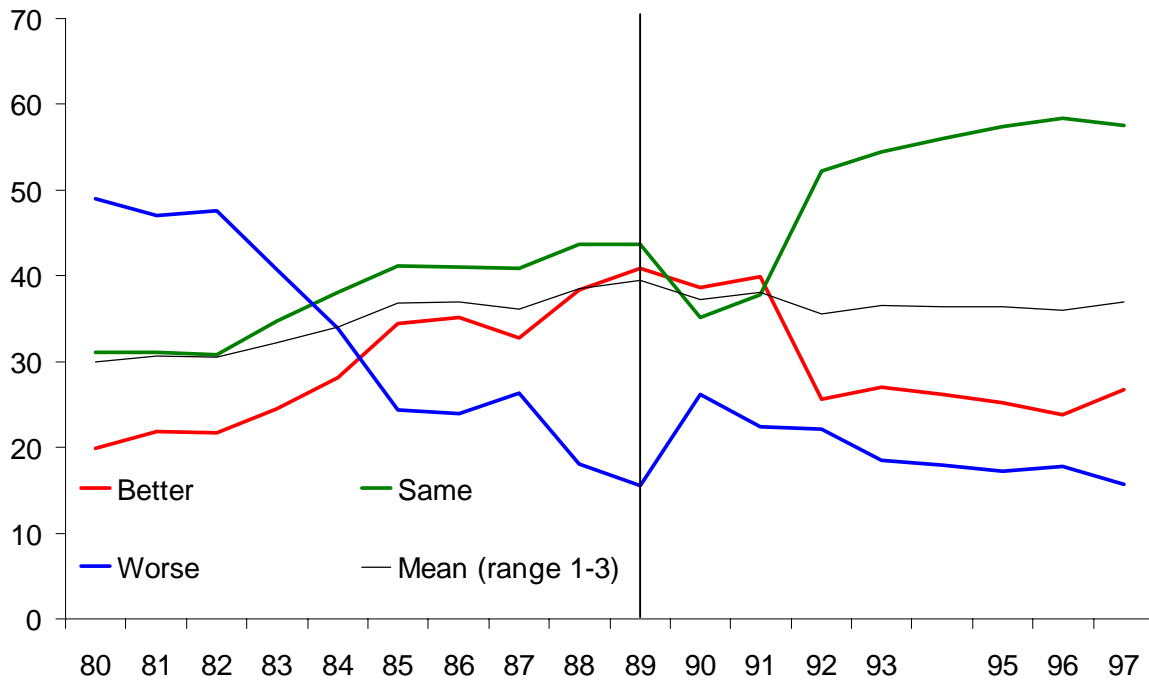


Figure 4 - Percentage Support for Party Families 1975-1999 (by Eurobarometer)



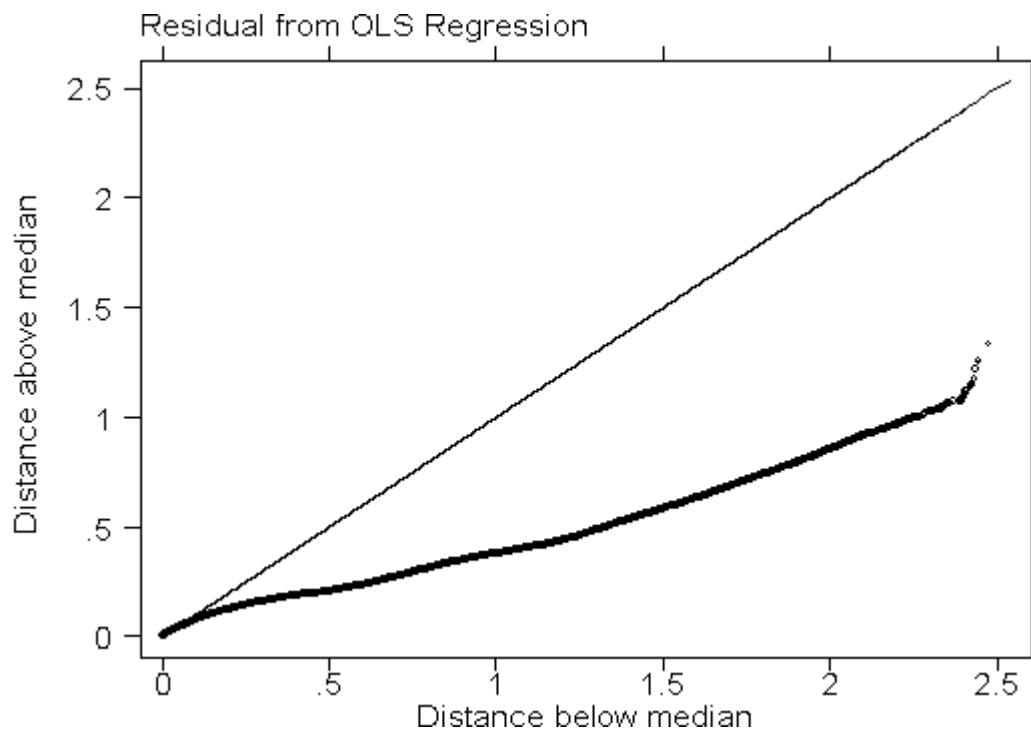

**Personal Expectations 1980-89 and Personal Economic Expectations 1990-97**

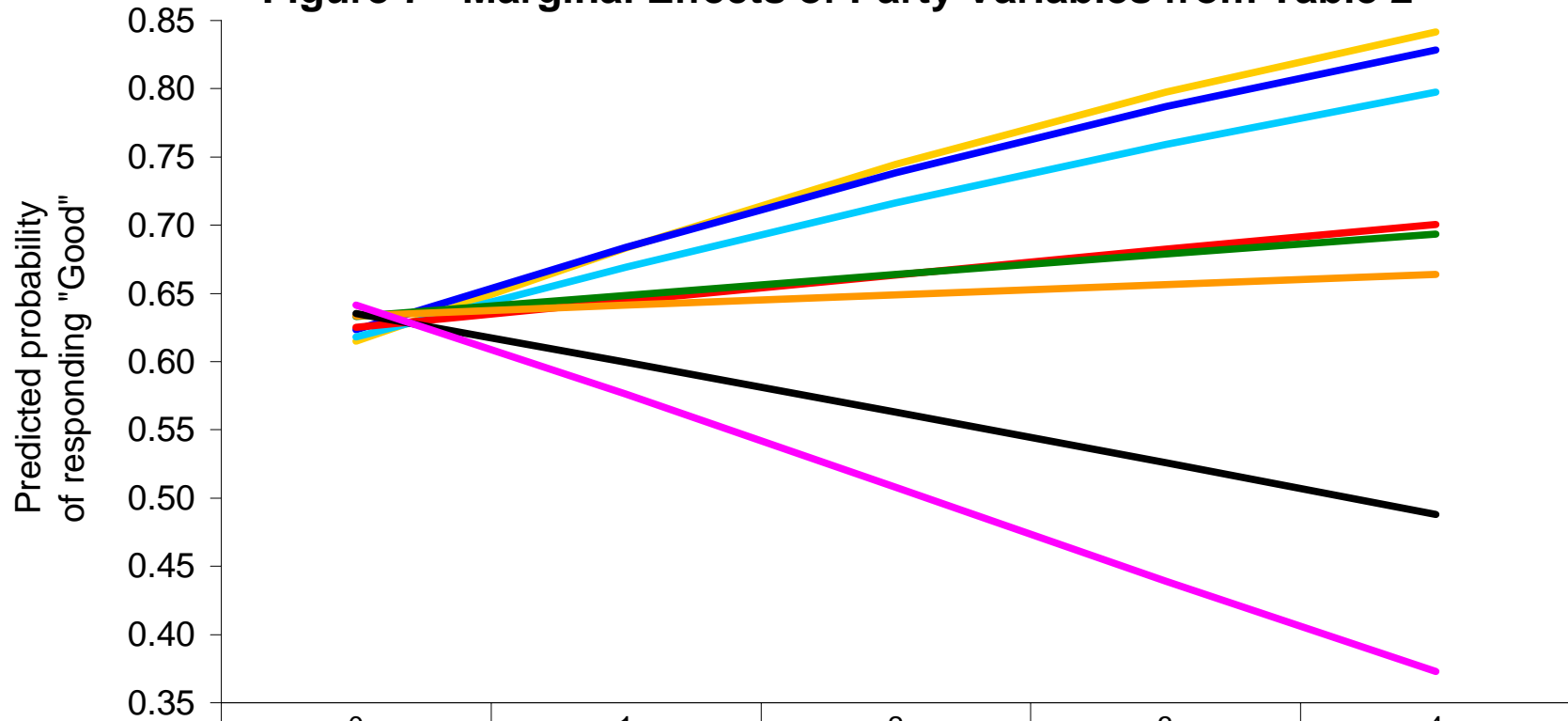

**Normality Test of Residuals in OLS regression of Equation 1 (see Table 2)**

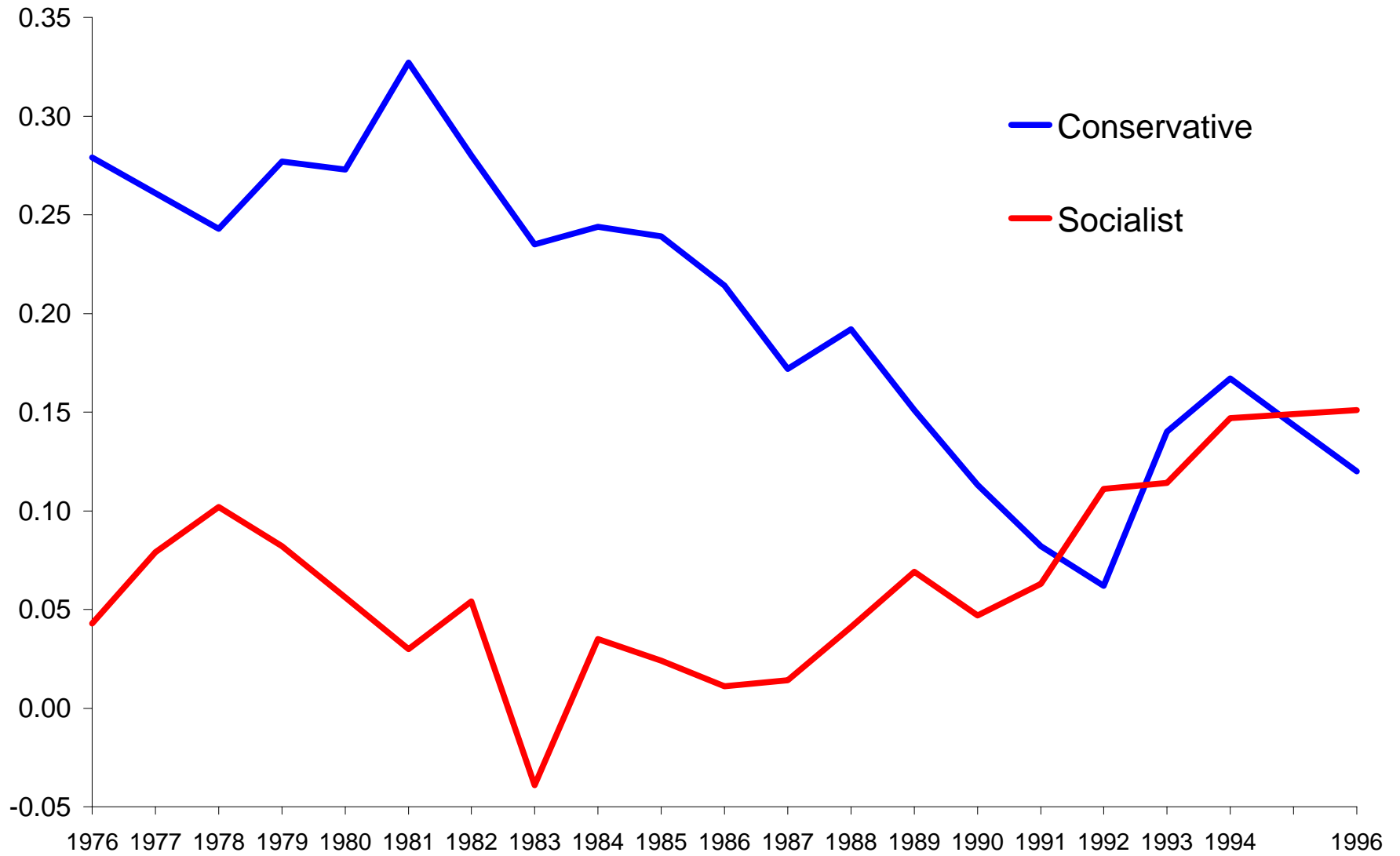


**Figure 7 - Marginal Effects of Party Variables from Table 2**

**Predicted Probabilities of Party Attachment Variables Over Time**

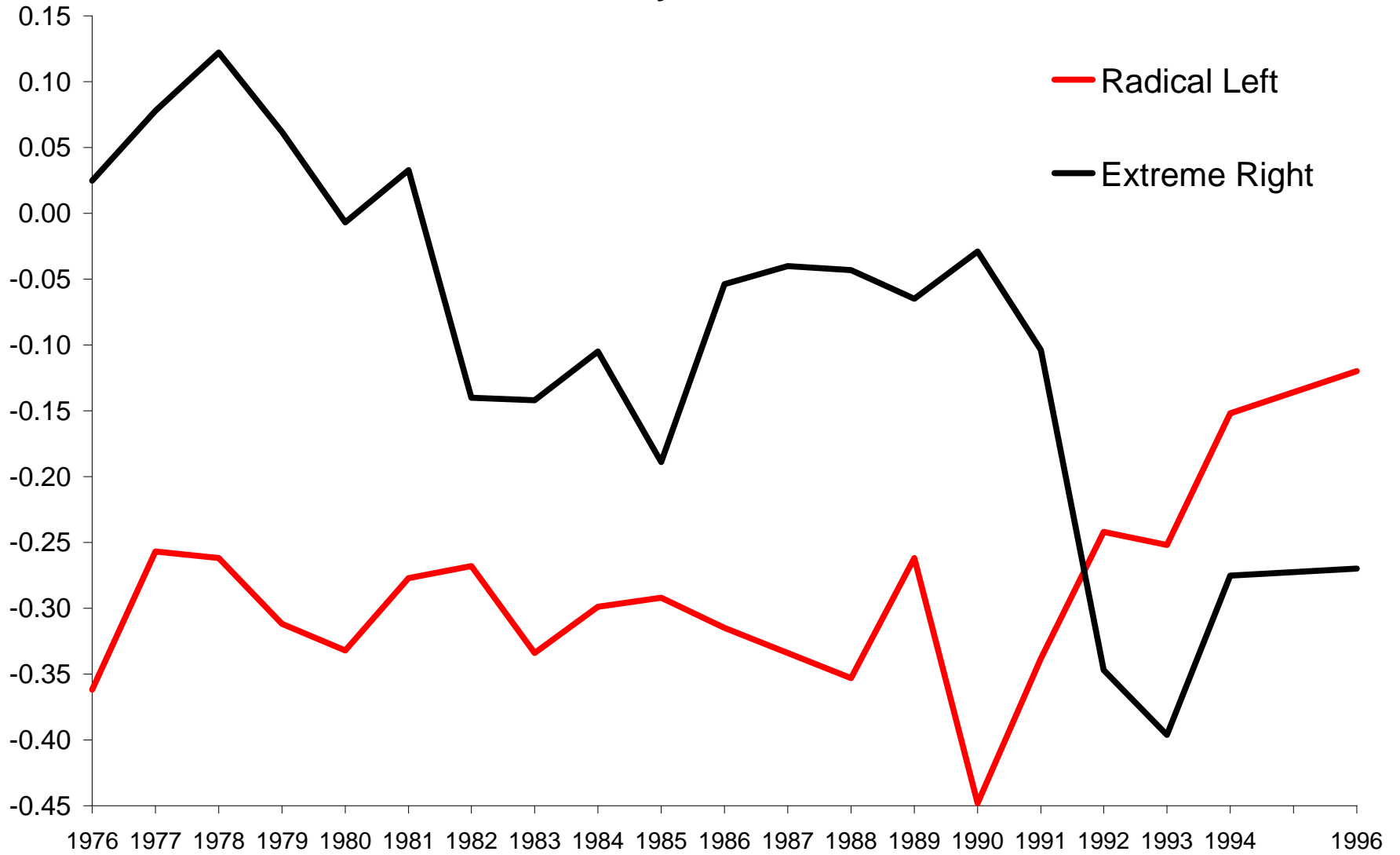
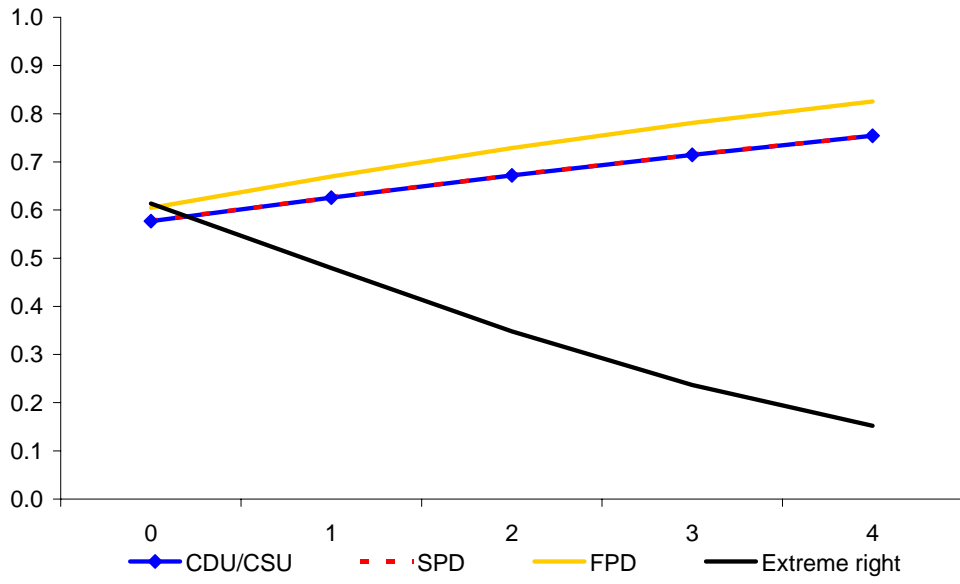
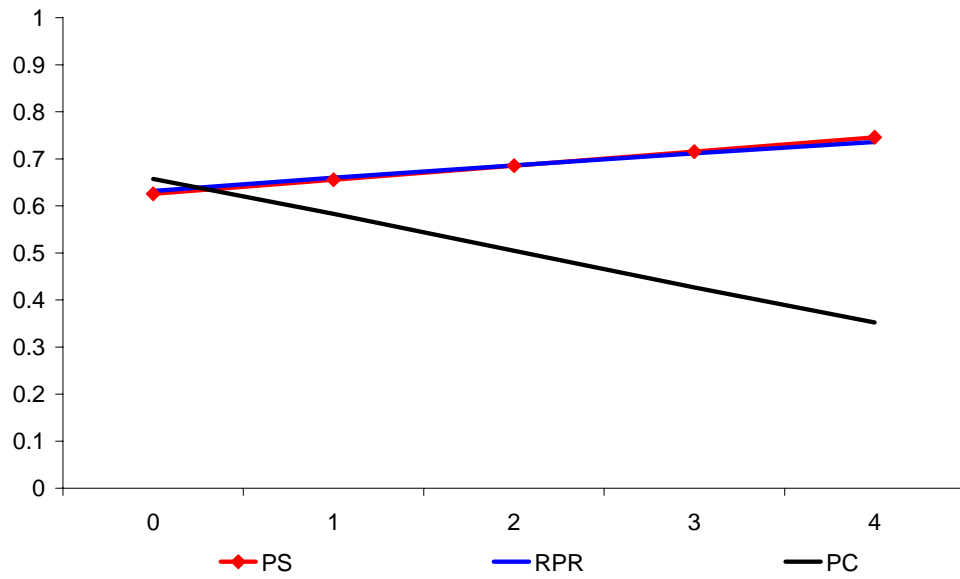

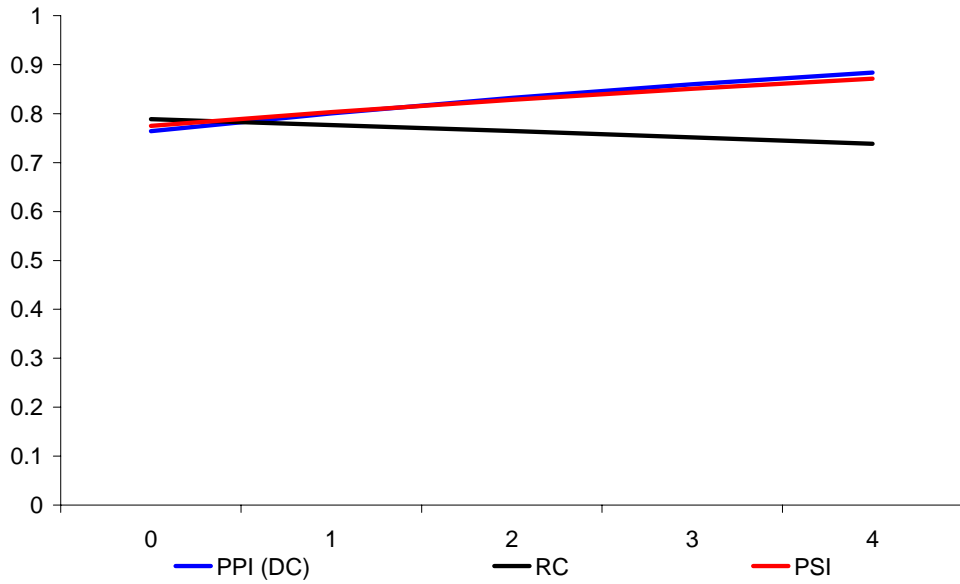
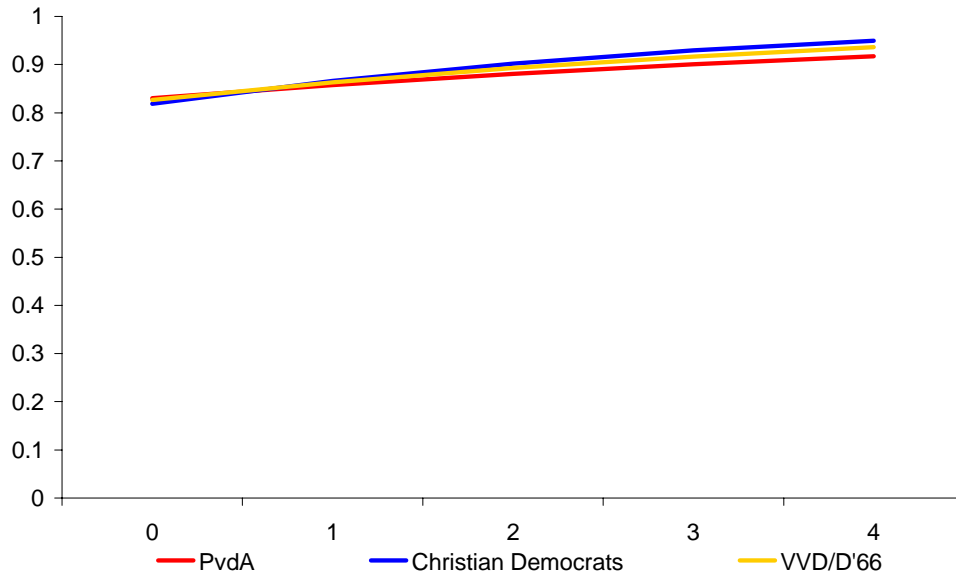
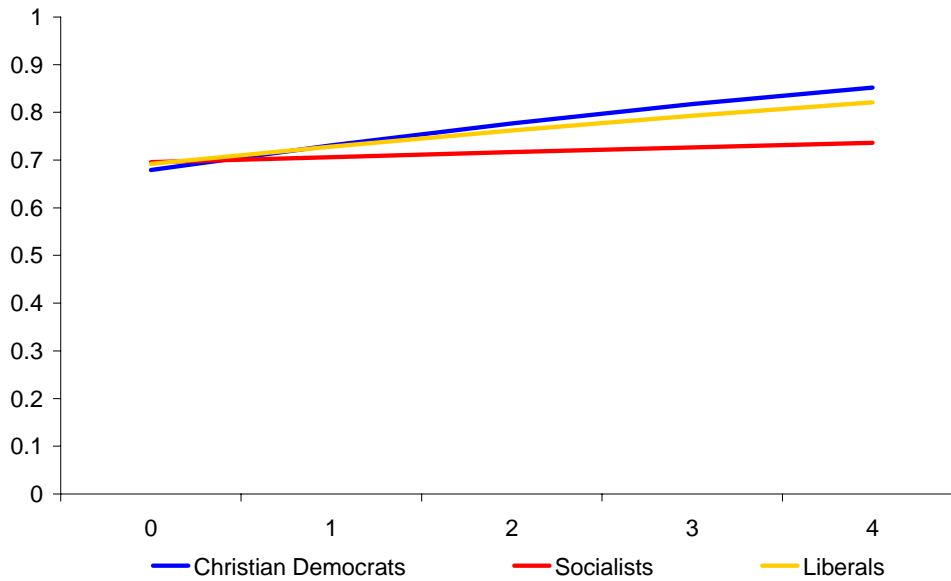


Figure 10 - continued

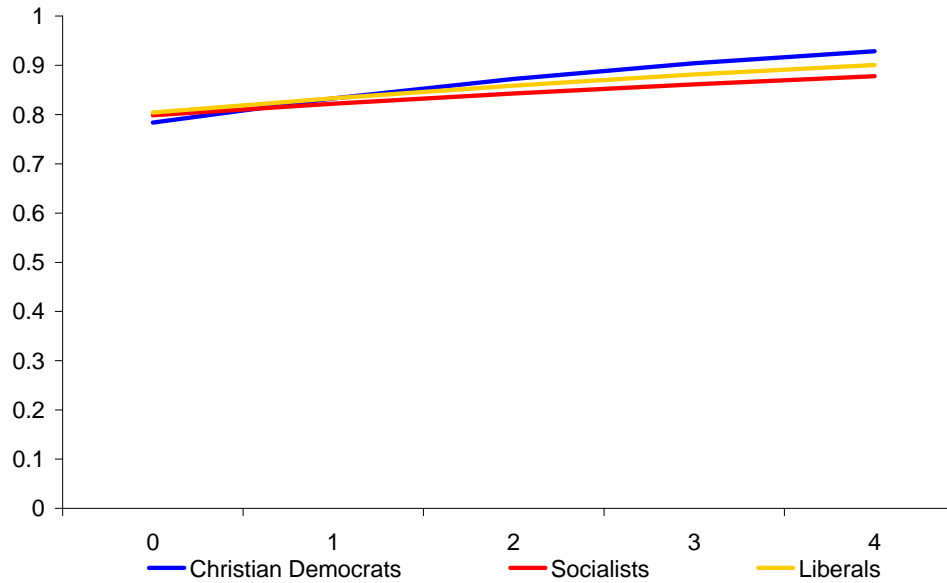


Figure 10 - continued
